

Colonel Timothy M. Gallagher Chief of Staff 1st Theater Sustainment Command

Colonel Timothy Gallagher, a native of Lynn, Massachusetts, commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the U.S. Army Ordnance Corps in July 1998 upon graduation from Norwich University in Northfield, Vermont.

His first assignment was the 4th Forward Support Battalion, Division Support Command, 4th Infantry Division at Fort Hood, Texas from 1999 to 2002 serving in one of the Army's first forward support companies under Force XXI in support of a mechanized infantry

battalion and as the Support Operations Maintenance Officer on the battalion staff.

In 2003, he reported to 1st Brigade, 10th Mountain Division (Light Infantry) at Fort Drum, New York where he served as the Assistant Brigade S-4 in support of OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM (OEF) in Kandahar Province, Afghanistan. Upon return from OEF, he stood-up and commanded a forward support company in support of a light infantry battalion and deployed in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM (OIF) in Baghdad, Iraq. In November 2006, COL Gallagher served as an Assistant Professor of Military Science at Norwich University in Northfield, Vermont where he served as the lead instructor for the third largest Military Science III class in the Nation.

Following CGSC, he returned to 1st Brigade Combat Team, 10th Mountain Division (Light Infantry) where he served as the Battalion Executive Officer and Support Operations Officer for the 10th Brigade Support Battalion, deploying to Regional Command-North in support of OEF. In September 2012, COL Gallagher next served in a joint assignment with the United States Marine Corps at the MAGTF Staff Training Program on Quantico, Virginia where he served as an Observer, Trainer, Collector (OT/C) in support of general officer MAGTF Command Element training around the world. From May 2015 to May 2017, he commanded the 832d Ordnance Battalion on Fort Lee, VA training future Ordnance leaders across 20 MOSs of Initial Entry Training. Following battalion command, he served as the Enlisted Ordnance Branch Chief, U.S. Army Human Resources Command, Fort Knox, KY. Upon completion of Senior Service College, he served as the Chief of Strategic Operations and Plans for the 1st Theater Sustainment Command in Kuwait. His latest assignment was Brigade Commander for the 4th Cavalry Brigade, 1st Army Division East and currently serves as the Chief of Staff at 1st Theater Sustainment Command.

He is a graduate of the Ordnance Officer Basic Course at Aberdeen Proving Ground in 1999, the Combined Logistics Captains Career Course at Fort Lee, Virginia in 2003, the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, KS in 2010, and JPME2 at the Joint Forces Staff College in 2012. From 2018 to 2019, he was a Senior Service College Fellow at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology Center for Transportation and Logistics.

His awards and decorations include the Legion of Merit, Bronze Star Medal with 2 oak leaf clusters, Meritorious Service Medal with 4 oak leaf clusters, Army Commendation Medal with 2 oak leaf clusters, Army Achievement Medal with 2 oak leaf clusters, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Iraqi Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Overseas Service Medal with numeral 3 device, NATO medal and the Combat Action Badge. He is also a recipient of The Ordnance Order of Samuel Sharpe.
