

Brig. Gen. Clint E. Walker



Brigadier General (BG) Clint E. Walker assumed command of the 184th Expeditionary Sustainment Command on October 15, 2017.

BG Walker began his military career in May 1985, enlisting at age 17 as a Private (E-1). He earned his commission through Officer Candidate School in June 1988. His most recent assignment was Director, Joint Staff/Land Component Commander, Joint Force Headquarters – Mississippi.

He has served in various command and staff assignments, including Deputy Commander, Assistant Chief of Staff G3, Chief of Staff, and Assistant Chief of Staff Support Operations, 184th Expeditionary Sustainment Command; Battalion Commander, 106th Brigade Support Battalion, 155th Armored Brigade Combat Team; Security, Plans and Operations Officer, Support Operations Officer, 114th Area Support Group; Theater Supply and Services Officer, US Army Central (ARCENT) C4/377th Theater Sustainment Command; and other command and staff positions within the 106th Brigade Support Battalion, 155th Armored Brigade.

BG Walker has deployed in support of Operation Desert Shield and Desert Storm, Operation Iraqi Freedom in Kuwait, Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan and currently Operation Spartan Shield. BG Walker served during multiple periods of state active duty in response to natural disasters most notably during Hurricane Katrina relief operations.

BG Walker holds a Bachelor's of Science in Business Administration from the University of Southern Mississippi, a Master's of Business Administration from Jackson State University and a Master's of Strategic Studies from the United States Army War College. He has completed additional executive-level education at the Harvard Kennedy School in Homeland Security and the University of North Carolina – Chapel Hill in Logistics and Technology.

As a career logistician, BG Walker has completed the Dual Status Commander Qualification Program and has attained the Joint Officer Qualification Level III.

BG Walker works as a federal civilian employee at the United States Property and Fiscal Office for Mississippi since October of 1994, most recently serving as the Director of Internal Review.
